

Unit 2 Academic Foundation Announces Riedemann Scholarship

The Bond County Unit 2 Academic Foundation has announced a new scholarship in honor of Mabel and Roger Riedemann. The Riedemann Scholarship is a four-year scholarship to be awarded to a Greenville High School senior who has been accepted and enrolled in a four year college or university. Preference will be given to those enrolled at Greenville College or the University of Illinois in the fields of Business, Finance, Agriculture or Music Education.

The Riedemanns were lifelong residents of Bond County and graduates of Greenville High School. Roger worked at Bradford National Bank for over 70 years and served as its president from 1970 to 1993. Both he and Mabel loved Greenville, understood the value of education and were active in many aspects of community service.

The \$1,000 yearly scholarship will be awarded for the first time this spring to a 2017 graduate. Applications for the scholarship are available through the guidance office at Greenville High School.
